

SCRIPTURES FOR CONQUERORS

JOHN 8:36

If the Son sets you free, you shall be free indeed.

EXODUS 23:26

...the number of thy days I will fulfill.

PSALM 30:5

For His anger endures but for a moment; in His favor is life; weeping may endure for a night but joy comes in the morning.

JOHN 15:5

I am the vine, you are the branches...without Me you can do nothing.

LAMENTATIONS 3:22-23

It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; great is thy faithfulness.

PHILIPPIANS 4:13

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

PSALM 119:105

Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path.

ROMANS 8:31

What shall we say then to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?

ROMANS 8:35, 37

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him that loved us.

ROMANS 8:38-39

For I am persuaded that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

JOHN 8:32

And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall set you free.

JOHN 10:27-28

My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me: and I give them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man ever pluck them out of my hand.

JOHN 6:35

...I am the Bread of Life: he that comes to Me shall never hunger, and he that believes on Me shall never thirst.

PSALM 139:14

I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made...

JOHN 8:12

...I am the Light of the World: he that follows me shall not walk in darkness but shall have the light of life.

JEREMIAH 29:11

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not evil, to give you an expected end.

JOHN 10:7

Then Jesus said unto them again...I am the Door of the sheep.

PSALM 5:12

For thou, Lord, will bless the righteous; with favor will thou compass him as with a shield.

JOHN 10:11

I am the Good Shepherd: the Good Shepherd gives His life for His sheep.

HEBREWS 10:23

Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful.

JOHN 11:25

I am the Resurrection and the Life. The one who believes in Me will live, even though they die.

JAMES 1:12

Blessed is the man who endures temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.

JOHN 14:6

...I am the Way, the Truth and the Life: no man comes unto the Father but by Me.

2 PETER 3:9

The Lord is...not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

JOHN 15:1

I am the True Vine and My Father is the Husbandman.

JOHN 10:10

...I am come that you may have life and have it more abundantly.

PSALM 91:15

He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him.

JOHN 14:1

Let not your heart be troubled: you believe in God, believe also in Me.

JOHN 14:18-19

I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you...because I live, you shall live also..

ISAIAH 58:9

Then you will call and the Lord will answer; you will cry for help and He will say: Here am I.

PROVERBS 1:33

...But whoever listens to Me will live in safety and be at ease, without the fear of harm.

JOHN 14:27

Peace I leave with you: My peace I give you. I do not give it to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.

PSALM 103:8

The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love.

JOHN 15:12-13

My command is this: Love one another as I have loved you. Greater love has no man than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends.

ISAIAH 40:31

But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.

PSALM 91: 1-2

He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in Him will I trust.

JOHN 16:33

...In the world you shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

PSALM 91:11-12

For He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep thee in all thy ways. They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest you dash your foot against a stone.

2 CHRONICLES 7:14

If my people, which are called by My Name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My Face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from Heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

PROVERBS 8:17

I love them that love Me; and those that seek Me early shall find Me.

PSALM 34:18

The Lord is nigh to them that are of a broken heart, and saves such as be of a contrite spirit.

JOEL 2:13

...Return to the Lord your God, for He is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and He relents from sending calamity.
